


















At a glance!

- Courses can be booked from one week and are available any Monday except for complete beginners and during public holidays.
- The maximum class size is 12 (average 7-8) in General English classes, 6 (average 4) for the Business English afternoon workshops.
- Language Training Needs Analysis and Placement Tests are sent prior to the course start date so that our students can begin their lesson as soon as they arrive.
- End of course certificates are given to our students on their last day.

Serviced Apartments


High quality apartments for short term and long term stays in the city centre.

By plane:

Many low-cost airlines (Easyjet, Ryanair, Jet 2 etc.) fly into and out of Manchester International Airport and John Lennon Liverpool airports.

Train, bus and taxi services are available from these airports direct to Manchester city centre.


By train:

There are three railway stations in the city centre with fast and frequent trains to many cities around Great Britain. Average journey times: Manchester to London - 2 hours, Manchester to Liverpool - 1 hour, Manchester to York - 15 hours

Travelling around Manchester:

Manchester's excellent public transport network makes travelling around Manchester city centre and its suburbs very easy. You can travel by tram, free shuttle bus, taxi or bus.
