## Description

Cambridge English Young Learners tests introduce children to everyday written and spoken English and are an excellent way for them to gain confidence and improve their English. They are a series of fun and engaging activity-based English language tests created for children. The tests are written around familiar topics and focus on the skills needed to communicate effectively in English through listening, speaking, reading and writing.

All candidates receive a certificate for the level they obtain. There is no pass or fail result. Students are encouraged to move through the three levels: Starters, Movers and Flyers.

## Summary

- Centres: Eastbourne, Vinehall and Handcross
- Hours: 5 hours across two weeks (instead of *Story Time* at Eastbourne and *Enrichment* at Vinehall and Handcross)
- Ages: 6–14
- Level: Starters (Pre-A1 Complete Beginners), Movers (A1 Beginners) and Flyers (A2 Elementary)
- Instruction: One teacher per 14 students
- Fee: £150 two weeks
- Fee includes: Exam enrolment fee, preparation and certificate

Course & Exam: 9–22 Jul (Exam 19 Jul), 23 Jul–5 Aug (Exam 3 Aug) and Handcross only 6–19 Aug (Exam 17 Aug)
