English Camp

Morning English classes feature English as an Additional Language. Campers practice reading, writing, listening, and speaking. Children are placed into groups by ability level. No prior language knowledge is required to attend camp or participate in the English language summer camp program.

Karlovy Vary (also known as Carlsbad) is a perfect place for the Carlsbad International School. It is a picturesque old town, with lots of history, colour and beautiful architecture which dates back to its founder Roman Emperor Charels IV. The town is quiet, but has everything needed for a great place to live and learn!

Karlovy Vary is a spa city situated in western Bohemia, Czech Republic, on the confluence of the rivers Ohře and Teplá, approximately 120 km west of Prague.

It is historically famous for its hot springs (13 main springs, about 300 smaller springs). In the 19th century, it became a popular tourist destination, especially for international celebrities, members of royal families, politicians, composers, writers and many others visiting for spa treatment. The city is also known for the Karlovy Vary International Film Festival and the popular Czech liqueur Karlovarská Becherovka. The glass manufacturer Moser Glass is also located in Karlovy Vary.
