Vacation English

Our Vacation English program provides students with the opportunity to learn English, make new friends from all over the world and have the summer of a lifetime, in one of the most popular seaside resorts in England. Students study English in the mornings and/or afternoons plus enjoy a range of full-day and half-day excursions.

Vacation English Plus

This programme is the same as Vacation English except that students also get to have evening activities, three times a week. Please note that the age range for Vacation English Plus is different and only takes place in the summer.

Transfers: Sunday

Price includes accompanied transfer to and from London Heathrow* with the arrival and departure times listed in the Price List or group quote. Transfers outside of these times and dates are subject to an additional cost.

Transfers may involve a waiting time of up to two hours after students have cleared immigration.

*Gatwick, Luton, St Pancras, London City and Stansted arrivals and departures incur a supplement charge and are usually transferred via Heathrow which may incur additional waiting time.

Transfers from other airports are available upon request and additional costs will be charged.

Unaccompanied Minors

Some airlines insist on students under 16 years of age being booked, at an extra cost to the client, as unaccompanied minors. This means a member of airport staff will stay with the child until they are handed over to LAL staff at Arrivals.

It is important that this charge is paid for as a <u>RETURN</u> payment, otherwise there could be a delay in the student checking-in on their return which could result in a missed flight.

In addition to this, LAL will charge a supplement of GBP 30 each way to cover the additional time needed for our staff to pick up and drop off at the airport. This supplement must be paid at the time of the booking.

LAL provides the contact details of the actual person meeting the student one week in advance. If contact details are needed earlier, LAL cannot guarantee that the person

nominated will be the person collecting the student so the information may change nearer the time as above.

Accommodation, Catering & Welfare

LAL Torbay offers homestay and hotel options for 2019.

Type of Residential Accommodation (minimum age: 14)

- Hotel offering:
 - o 2 or 4 beds per room
 - o en-suite bathrooms
- Entry to hotel by key

Residential Rooms

- Single Bed (some have bunk-style beds;)
- Carpet
- Wardrobe or hanging area
- Rooms have a lock and key supplied to students

Homestay

- Shared rooms, two or more beds per room
- Shared bathroom
- Maximum of four Young Learners per Homestay
- Some rooms have bunk-style beds

Staff and Room Allocation

- Hotel staffed overnight by LAL staff
- Students allocated to rooms on arrival (Hotel)
- Homestay students allocated in advance
- Advance rooming and sharing requests cannot be guaranteed

Meals

- All accommodation types provide full-board
- Breakfast is provided by the homestays and at the hotel
- A packed lunch is provided either by the homestay or the school
- Evening meal is provided by the homestay, in the hotel or in a local restaurant

Other Welfare Information

- Curfew times are:
 - 12-13 year olds: 21.30
 14-15 year olds: 22.00
 16-17 year olds: 22.30
- Students under 12 years are not allowed out without adult supervision
- Towels are provided in all accommodation types but beach towels are not provided
- All bedding provided
