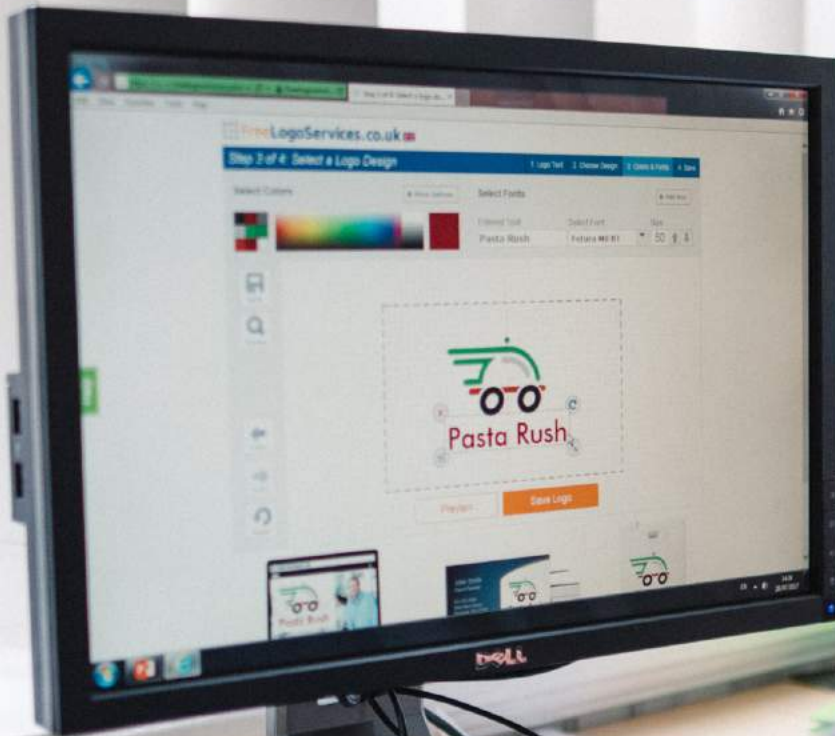

ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROGRAMME

- ▶ The course covers four skills: listening, speaking, reading and writing, with research projects and spoken presentations giving students the opportunity to practice their learning.

- ▶ Students also have the opportunity to sit the Trinity College London SELT English exams. These English exams are approved for use when making visa applications or applying to UK institutions for further studies.
- ▶ Various levels of English test are available and we will advise on the best route for each student during their stay such as: FCE, CAE and IELTS. For any external English test, there will be a fee by the exam board.

Academic Activities

FINANCE & BANKING

This course comprises of basic modules which explain the basics of the banking world and finance. The course looks at real case studies and teaches students how to extract relevant information from resources. The course also involves learning how to create tables, graphs and models. Students will have a finance project which they will have to present to their peers and the end of the course.

LAW

Students will get a Harry Potter experience as well as time to buy a book in the famous bookshop. Later in the day, we will take a short trip by train to Bicester village, one of the largest shopping outlets in Europe. A cultural day followed by a bit of shopping will make it an unforgettable experience for many!

THORPE PARK

Thorpe Park has a large variety of exciting attractions, roller-coasters and fun activities to do. Students will have a chance to visit and experience rides in a British Theme Park.

STONEHENGE

Stonehenge is among the wonders of the world and is Europe's best-known pre-historic monument. Students can explore the ancient site on foot and visit the Neolithic houses to discover the tools and objects of everyday Neolithic life. The world-class visitor centre has 250 ancient objects on exhibit and a reconstruction of the face of a 5,500-year-old man. Students will then enjoy a lovely English-themed picnic in the grounds and discuss the history of Stonehenge while filling in their English project books.

Programme Details

ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE

- ▶ Students begin lessons on Monday morning and should arrive on Sunday afternoon.
- ▶ On departure, students must vacate their rooms by 10am Sunday morning.
- ▶ When booking flights, please check with your airline what documents are required if your child is classified as an 'unaccompanied minor'. This usually applies to travellers 17 years old and under.
- ▶ For students 18 years old and under, an Orange Tree Courses staff member will meet them in the airport arrivals hall and on departure will accompany them to the departures hall entrance.
- ▶ For arrivals times other than Sunday afternoon, please make arrangements with our Admissions Office. An additional fee for individual airport transfers will be applicable.

FEES PACKAGE INCLUDES:

- ▶ Full board (3 daily meals) and lodging in the school accommodation
- ▶ Accommodation is in a large room with 4 other students of various nationalities (usually)
- ▶ Indoor and outdoor sports activities
- ▶ Evening entertainment
- ▶ Full day excursions on both Wednesdays and on the first Saturday
- ▶ 24-hour security surveillance with a high level security system, which also includes CCTV surveillance around the grounds and gated entrances, and security guards on patrol.
- ▶ Study materials
- ▶ Core programme, academic activities and sporting activities.

Note: Fees are based on Sunday arrivals and Sunday departures.
