Time to central London: 15 mins by public transport.

Local Transport

Bus: The 188 bus from Greenwich Church Street takes you into central London through Waterloo and Embankment. Buses to Lewisham include the 180 and the 199.

Rail: Trains from Greenwich station go to Cannon Street every 10 minutes. The DLR from Cutty Sark will take you past Canary Wharf into Bank.

Security
