



BUSINESS COMMUNICATION

This course is designed as a general introduction to concepts and vocabulary associated with the modern business world. STAR is extremely specific in regard to muscle movement, and does not rely on continuous repetition to produce accurate vocalization, instead using clear and easy to understand muscle training systems.

ADMISSION & ORIENTATION

Admission Procedure

- Submit the ONLINE REGISTRATION FORM (http://roiisapplication.ca) or Complete email.
- We will send you an invoice for all applicable fees
- Send payment by wire transfer, bank draft or money order to ROIIS
- We will send you a Letter of Acceptance once full payment of fees has been received.
- Apply for a visa, if needed, once you receive your Letter of Acceptance

Visa & Immigration

In order to study in Canada, you may need a study permit, and/or a temporary resident visa. Though not everyone must have these documents, it is important that you carefully read the Citizenship and Immigration Canada website: (https://www.canada.ca/en/immigration-refugees-citizenship/services/study-canada.html) or consult with the Canadian High Commission in your country of residence.

HEALTH INSURANCE

The Government of Canada does not pay for the medical costs of foreign students. The medical expenses for emergencies, sudden illness or accident while studying in Canada could cost a fortune without adequate coverage.

Students are responsible to obtain and maintain medical insurance for the duration of your study.

RCIIS recommends that all students have health insurance for the full duration of their stay in Canada.

On Your First Day

On your first day, you should expect the following schedule:

- Submission of your passport, visa, and insurance policy
- You will receive an introductory greeting from our counselors and a confirmation of your course registration.
- You will be seated while waiting for your placement test. This test consists of 2 parts: a speaking test, and a written test.
- Your name will be called for the placement test which will decide what level and programs you need to begin with in RCIIS
- After the placement test, our staff will give you a general orientation regarding the school and its policies.
- Please listen very carefully to our orientation; some of the school policies are very important for your success at RCIIS.
- At the end of the orientation, you will have the opportunity to take part in a small group discussion with our counselors who speak your native language. They will answer some of your questions and make copies of your passport, visa and insurance policies.
- After the session with our counselors, you will be dismissed from school for the day. We will inform you regarding the arrangement of your classes as well as your schedule before you begin your program on the 2nd day
- RCIIS requires all students to speak only in English while at school, starting from your first day. We hope you enjoy your time with RCIIS!

REFUND POLICY

Refund Policies

The registration fee, all placement fees and all Health Insurance Policy purchase fees are non-refundable in ALL cases. A refund of fees will not be given if a student does not attend classes. Please consider when applying that student authorization or visitor visas can take up to several weeks to process.

Students have a 48-hour contract cancellation period prior to signing the registration contract.

Rejected VISA

If your visa is rejected, RCIIS will refund all fees, minus the registration fee, only upon receipt of the original Letter of Acceptance and the official letter of refusal from the Canadian Embassy.

Cancellation After Receiving Visa

There is no refund of any fee for applicants who have successfully received their visas with the Letter of Acceptance and other documents and assistance from ROIIS.

Cancellation before the Start of Program

If RCIIS receives written notice of withdrawal from the student along with the original Letter of Acceptance issued by the school at least 30 calendar days before the start of the program, a cancellation fee of 25% of the total tuition fee will be charged. If less than 30 calendar days, a cancellation fee of 50% of the total tuition fee will be charged.

If for any reason, a student is dismissed from ROIS, no refund will be made for the remainder of their tuition

The tuition fees are non-transferable.

For Package Students, there will be no refunds for the cancellation of individual programs

Absence/Vacation

Students absent for more than 1 week, without notifying the school in writing, will be removed from the class and may have to re-enter the program. Tuition fees cannot be extended for the vacation time for any reason, therefore you will not receive a Letter of Attendance from the school.

Deferrals

You may defer your registration starting date one time only. You will be charged 10% of the tuition fee as a deferral fee before the starting date. Deferring after the starting date will incur a charge of 25% and the institute will decide your returning session. There will be no deferrals for subsequent terms.

Applying through an Authorized Representative

Must request and obtain refund directly from the reprehensive.

Accommodation Refund

The Accommodation and Airport Pick-up placement fees are non-refundable.

Leaving Homestay

Students must inform the host and school of moving out at least 4 weeks before it is to take place. Otherwise, students will be charged until the 4 weeks are met plus \$200.00 administration fee.
